For AYHL Playoffs, final standings POINTS are used to determine which teams will participate and in what order they will be seeded.

If teams are tied in points the following tiebreaker formula is used in this order:

- Most points earned between the tied teams in head to head competition
- Most overall wins this season using all League games played
- Goal differential between the tied teams
- Fewest goals allowed between the tied teams
- Goal differential this season using all League games played
- Fewest Goals allowed this season using all League games played

Once a criteria firmly establishes the position of any tied team, that team will be placed in that position, and the remaining teams will start the tie breaking process from the beginning to determine the order of finish for the remaining teams.

<u>NOTE:</u> For the purpose of AAHA District Tournament bound purposes, only game versus other AAHA District Teams will be considered in the application of this formula. For League Champion and League Playoff purposes, all games shall be used, as applicable with the entire formula.
